Romans 3:21-31 – God is both Just and Justifier

For Christ also dies for our sins once for all, the just for the unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the Spirit". ... *1 Peter 3:18*

Words that Change Our Lives Forever...

1. **Atonement or to Atone** means to make amends, to repair a wrong or to remove the _____ of man.

- Jesus atoned for the sins of the world (1 John 2:2). This atonement is received by faith (Rom. 5:1; Eph. 2:8-9).
- Man is a sinner (Rom. 5:8) and cannot atone for himself. Therefore, it was the love of the Father that sent Jesus (1 John 4:10) to die in our place (1 Pet. 3:18) for our sins (1 Pet. 2:24).
- Because of the atonement, _____ with God is restored (Rom. 5:10).

2. **Justify, Justification:** God declares the sinner to be innocent of his sins.

- It is not that the sinner is now sinless but that he is "_____ " sinless.
- The sinner is not made righteous. Instead, justification is a legal act of imputing the righteousness of Christ to the believer (Rom. 4:11, Phil. 3:9).
- This justification is based on the shed _____ Jesus, (Rom. 5:9).
- This declaration of innocence is not without cost, for it required the satisfaction of God's Law, (Heb. 9:22). In justification, _____ of God fell upon Himself--Jesus.
- This justification is a gift of grace (Rom. 3:24) and by faith (Rom. 3:28).

3. **Propitiation** means the turning away of _____ by an offering.

- The propitiation was the shed blood of Jesus on the cross.

4. **Redemption** means to free someone from bondage or slavery by making _____.

- We were redeemed from the power of sin and the curse of the Law (Gal. 3:13) through Jesus (Rom. 3:24, Col. 1:14).
- We were _____ with a price (1 Cor. 6:20, 7:23)

5. **Salvation** means saving of a sinner from the righteous judgment of God when his sins are _____.

- He is cleansed.
- His relationship with God is restored, and he is made a new creature (2 Cor. 5:17).
- Salvation is a free gift (Rom. 6:23).
- We are saved from damnation. When anyone sins, and we all have (Rom. 3:23, 6:23), he deserves eternal separation from God (Isaiah 59:2). Yet, because of His love and mercy, God became a man (John 1:1, 14) and bore the sins of the _____ in His body on the cross (1 Pet. 2:24, 1 John 2:2).
- There is nothing we can do to earn the favor of God and we put our trust in what Jesus did for us on the cross (Eph. 2:8-9, 1 Cor. 15:1-4).
